Eligible donation items include the donation of toys (minimum of \$15.00 for each toy), good condition clean blankets, non-perishable foodstuffs (such as canned meats, fruits, vegetables, boxed potatoes, cakes, mixes, bagged rice, navy beans, pinto beans, Jell-O, condiments, and peanut butter and jelly), or a donation of \$25.00 cash for perishable supplies (such as for ham, eggs, turkey, butter, milk, bread, and potatoes). Dr. Johnson will be giving his current practice members a \$10.00 credit on their accounts for their donations.

However, non-practice members who wish to become practice members of either nutrition or chiropractic services (or both) will receive some giving from Dr. Johnson also. A donation to Annual Extended Hand Food Drive will give new Chiropractic practice members:

- * An exam to see where their current health condition stands.
- * A consultation to discuss how their health can be improved with our services.
